
Risk Assessment for Supervisors & Managers



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This course has been designed for supervisors and managers wanting to learn more about what work health and safety risk management means in the workplace. In every workplace, workers are exposed to day-to-day activities involving some kind of workplace health and safety risk, which needs to be identified and managed. These workplace risks apply to a broad range of roles across all industries and require appropriately trained and equipped employees to identify and manage them.

It allows you to develop the skills, knowledge and confidence required to identify work health and safety (WHS) hazards and assess and control the risk relating to those identified hazards. It involves contributing to the development, implementation and evaluation of risk controls according to legislative and organizational requirements.
